The Water Supply Authority must maintain such records in relation to the operation of adding fluoride to its public water supply as are required by the Committee, and in particular such records as will account, to the satisfaction of the Committee, for the receipt and disposition of fluoride used in connection with the addition of fluoride to the public water supply.

Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies Act 1966

A water supply authority must not, except as allowed by the Fluoridation Code, cause or permit a public water supply to be fluoridated by any person who is not a qualified operator. Maximum penalty: 25 penalty units and, in the case of a continuing offence, an additional 5 penalty units for each additional day for which the offence continues.

Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies Regulation 2017

Most water contains some fluoride but usually not enough to prevent cavities. Community water systems can add just the right amount of fluoride to local drinking water to prevent cavities. Community water fluoridation is recommended by nearly all public health, medical, and dental organizations.
